Overnight/Evening Advocate (Relief Staff)

Responsibilities

Providing individual and systems advocacy to victims of domestic and sexual violence in a residential setting. Advocacy services include providing crisis intervention, support and referral in person and over the 24-hour help line.

Qualifications

A minimum of one year demonstrated experience in advocating on behalf of victims of domestic and sexual violence; the ability to advocate within various systems including social services, economic, housing, legal, medical and educational systems; excellent written and communication skills; and the ability to work well with diverse populations and community organizations.

Hours

This position will be required to work at least one overnight shift during each pay period, as well as occasional evening and weekend shifts as they are available. Overnight shifts are typically 9 hours in length, starting at 10 or 10:30pm and end at 7 or 7:30am. Evening shifts typically start between 5 and 6pm and end at 10pm. Both overnight and evening shifts include weeknight and weekend hours. Relief Staff Advocates are required to work a minimum of 10 hours each month.
