Sexual Violence Virtual Support Group Tuesdays • 6:30-8:00 PM | Location: Zoom

Our 8-week program is structured around specific topics, including education on SV 101, managing anger, dealing with trauma triggers, regaining control, setting boundaries, practicing self-care, coping with the trauma, finding hope, and building resilience. **The group is open to individuals aged 16 and above of any gender. We encourage all members to attend every session.**
